

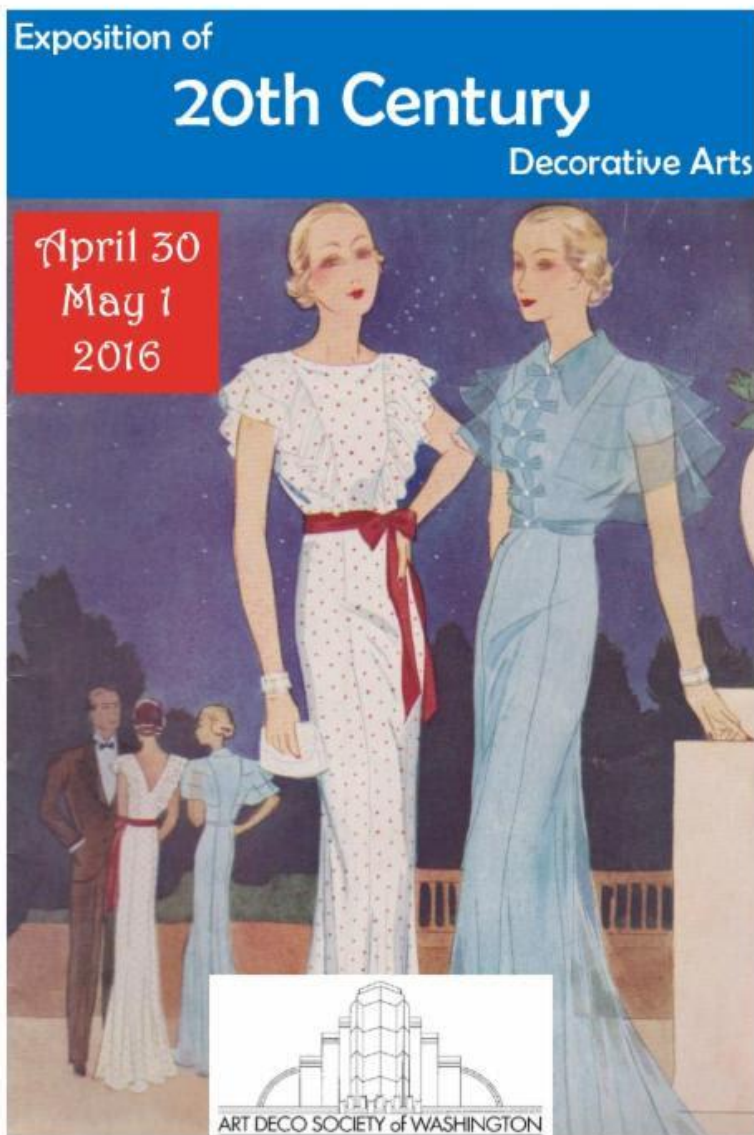

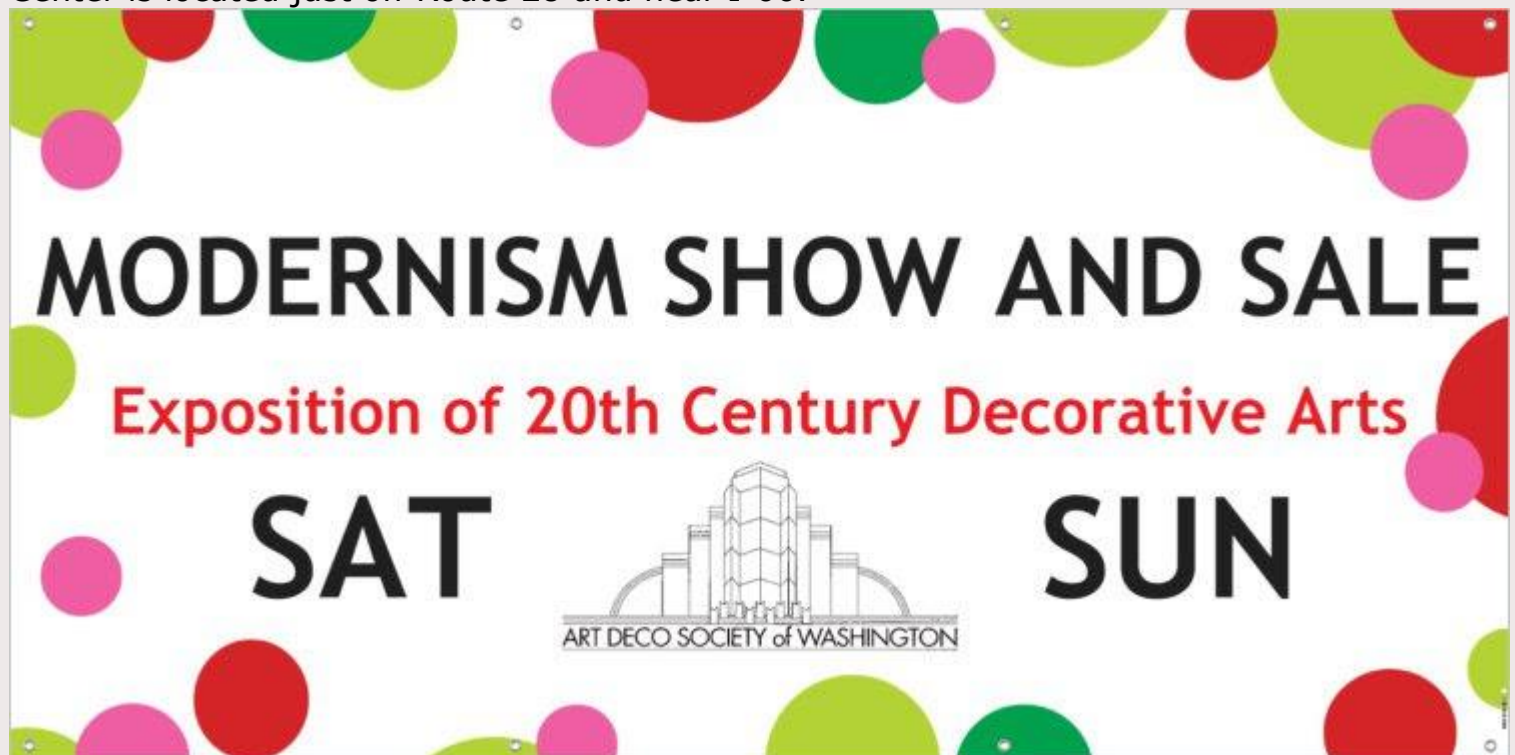
Attend the Expo


Return Sunday for the Book Signing


