

Limited Space Remains For 14th World Congress Day Registration Added in Cleveland

As the 14th World Congress on Art Deco and its pre- and post-Congress tours draw near, some programs are full and others are approaching capacity. The pre-Congress tour of Cincinnati is full and only three spots remain for the comprehensive post-Congress tour of Pittsburgh. Space

remains for the motorcoach transfers between Cincinnati and Detroit and between Cleveland and Pittsburgh and for the Frank House fundraiser in Pittsburgh.

The 20th Century Society USA has added a limited number of a la carte options to accommodate requests from Decophiles interested in attending part, but not all, of the extensive Cleveland program. Day registrations are now available for the Sunday, May 14th, opening reception (\$50), daily programs on Monday, May 15 (\$200), Tuesday, May 16 (\$200), Wednesday, May 17 (\$200), Thursday, May 18 (\$230), Friday, May 19 (\$200), Saturday, May 20 (\$200) and closing breakfast, Sunday, May 21 (\$50). A few spots also remain for the full Congress.
