LIFE IN THE AGE OF FITZGERALD

Beaded fringe bounced to the syncopated sounds of jazz, while illegal hooch sloshed in long stemmed glasses. The bull market prevailed and it didn't matter what you bought; stocks only went up. Names of the sport heroes still echo today: Walter Johnson, Babe Ruth, Jack Dempsey and Man O' War. On the surface, it was a glittering moment in time captured by F. Scott Fitzgerald in stories like *The Great Gatsby* and "Bernice Bobs Her Hair." We will exhibit a cross-section of the period with fashions from Paris, speakeasy cocktails, red hot jazz and weekend recreations.
