Registration Opens Wednesday October 5

Join the Art Deco Society of Washington and the Cleveland Park Historical Society for a focused walking tour of Connecticut Avenue in Cleveland Park. The tour will include interior access to some of this neighborhood's most exquisite apartment buildings from the 1920's and '30's, including Tilden Gardens, Sedgwick Gardens, The Broadmoor, Woodley Park Towers and, of course, the Kennedy Warren.

The tour will run from 9:50 am to about 2:00 pm and will include a mid-tour sit-down box lunch at the Broadmoor plus a talk by noted architectural historian and Best Addresses author James Goode at the Kennedy Warren.

Registration will open at 9 AM, Wednesday, October 5th. Active ADSW members will receive email notification with the registration link at that time.
