Join ADSW for a detailed interior tour of the Adams Building of the Library of Congress. We will also view the Art Deco exteriors of the Folger Shakespeare Library and the Lutheran Church of the Reformation.

**Save the Date--November 21-22, 2015**  
**Art Deco Pittsburgh**

ADSW is planning a 2-day tour of Art Deco Pittsburgh November 21-22, 2015. Among the sites under consideration are the Joseph Urban-designed Ballroom at the Omni William Penn Hotel, The Twentieth Century Club Ballroom, the Richard Meier-designed Giovanitti House, the

Walter Gropius- and Marcel Breuer-designed Frank House, the Cathedral of Learning, and numerous buildings in downtown.

In addition, the Carnegie Museum of Art has on permanent exhibit the 32-panel bas relief "Chariot of Aurora" from the Normandie. The Museum will also launch the first ever exhibition of the industrial designs of Peter Muller Munk on November 21, 2015. The Munk exhibition will close March 14, 2016.

This tour will not include visits to Fallingwater, Kentuck Knob, or Polymath Park. They will be included in a future tour.

## World Congress on Art Deco Shanghai, China November 1-6, 2015

The 2015 World Congress on Art Deco will be held November 1-6 in Shanghai, China. Partner hotels for the Congress are the [Jinjiang Metropolo Classic Hotel Off Bund](#), [Fairmont Peace Hotel](#) and the [Peninsula Shanghai](#) have all given World Congress attendees preferential group rates. Our three hotels are all on Shanghai's historic Bund, within an easy five minute walk of the Congress venue. All are Art Deco, but each reflect a different type of Shanghai Art Deco.
